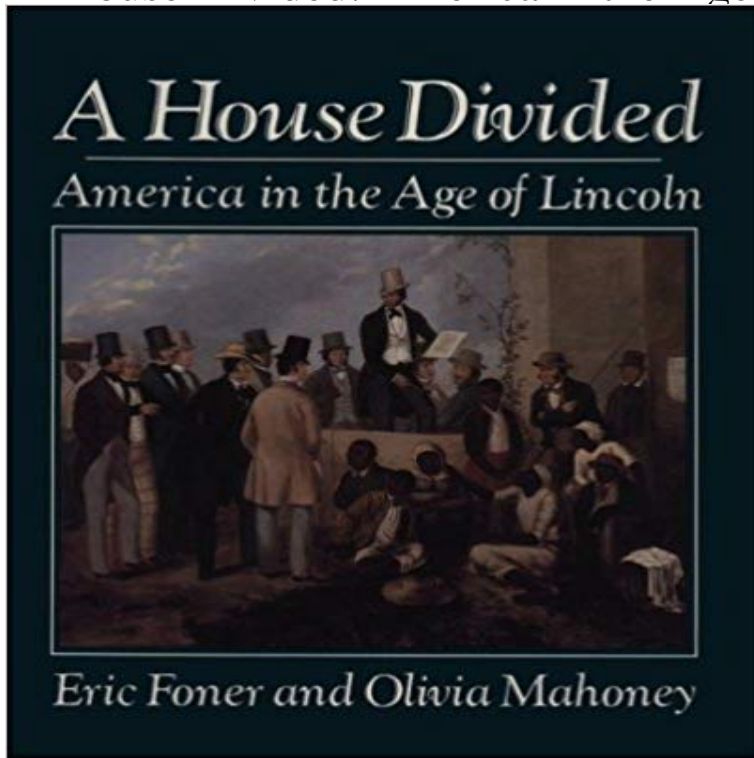


# A House Divided: America in the Age of Lincoln
