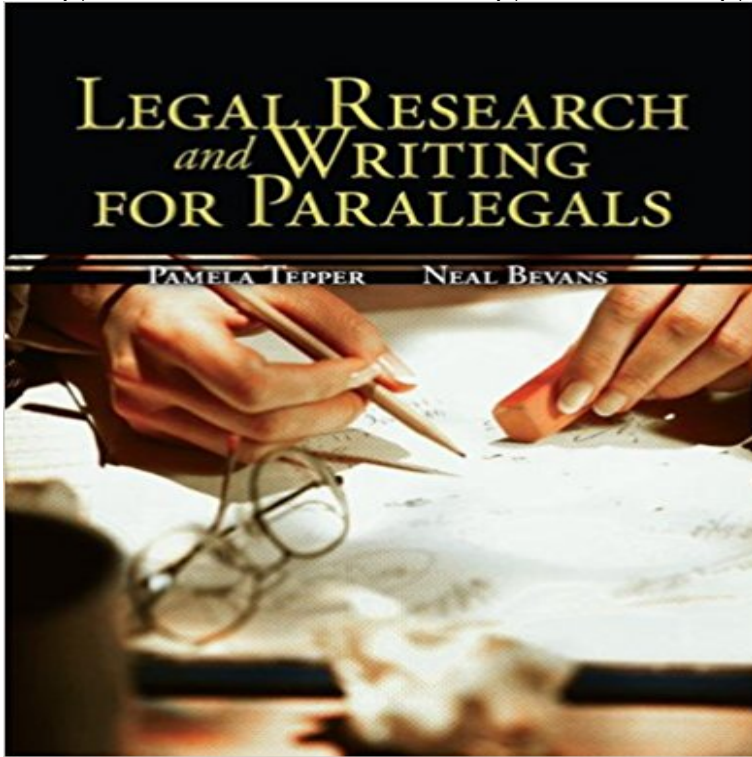


Legal Research & Writing for Paralegals
