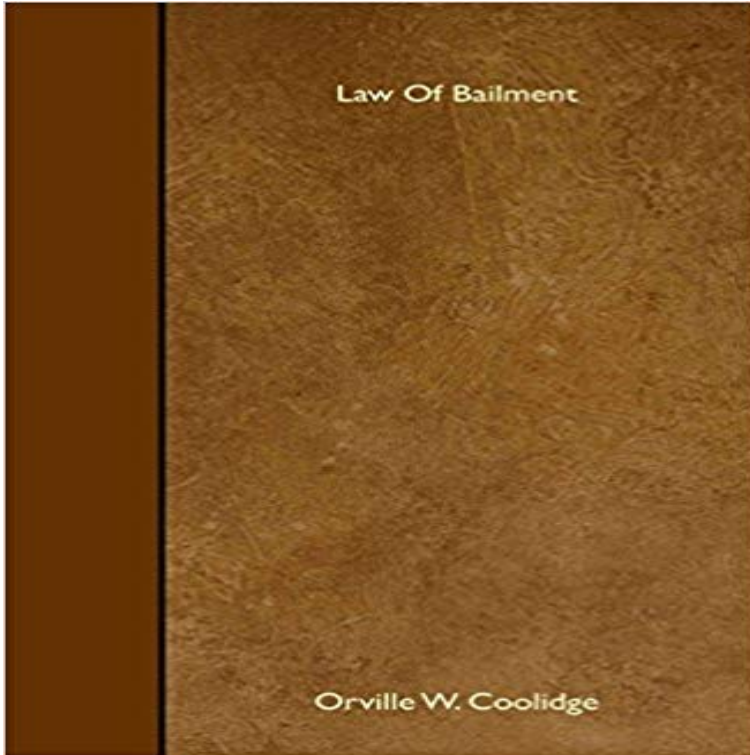

When a bailment is created, the article is said to have been bailed. One who delivers the article is the bailor. Bailment describes a legal relationship in common law where physical possession of personal property, or a chattel, is transferred from one person (the bailor) to another person (the bailee) who subsequently has possession of the property.
