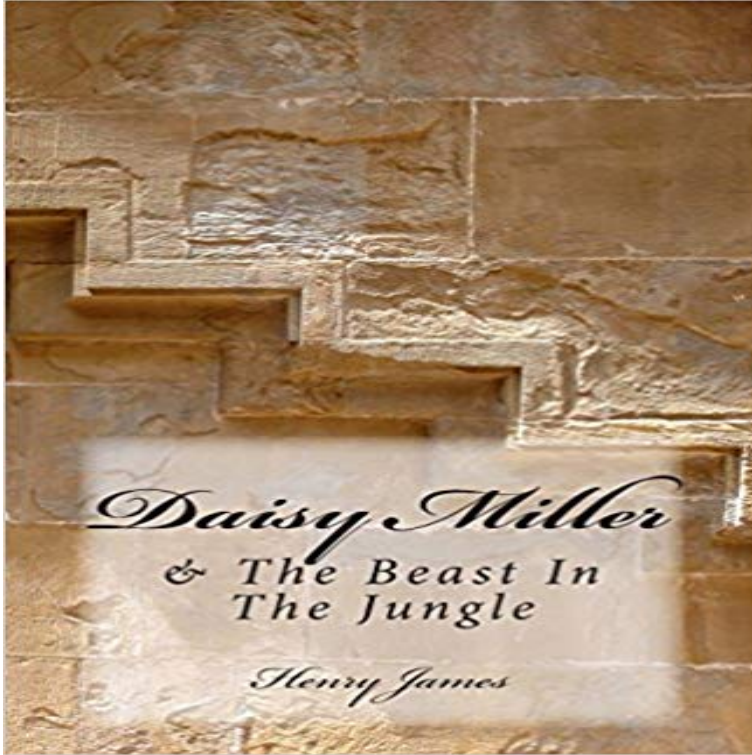


# Daisy Miller: A Study In Two Parts: & The Beast In The Jungle
