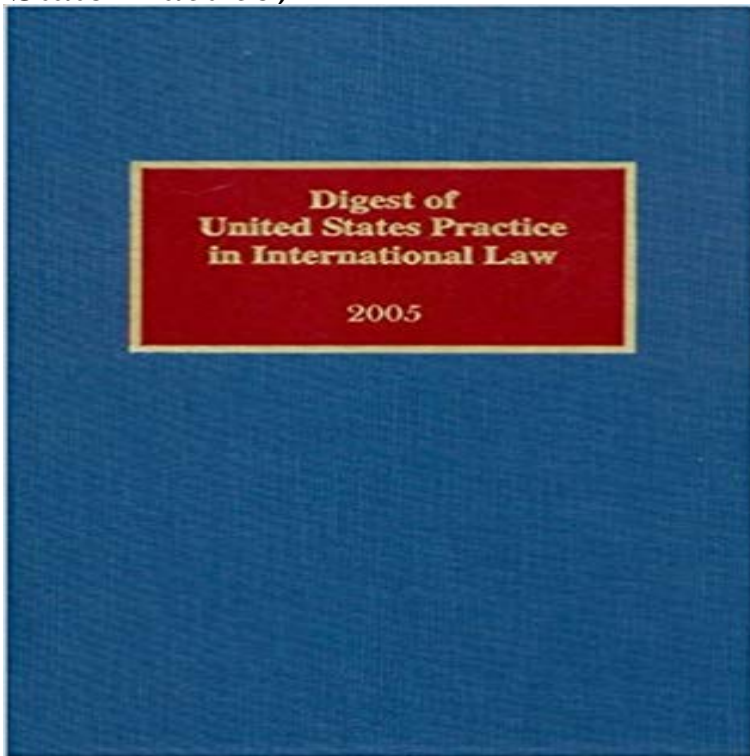


Digest of United States Practice in International Law, 2005 (Digest of State Practice)

All of the documents which are excerpted in the Digest are selected by members of the Legal Advisers Office of the U.S. Department of State, based on their judgments about the significance of the issues, their potential relevance to future situations, and their likely interest to practitioners and scholars. In almost every case, the commentary to each excerpt is accompanied by a citation to the full text.
