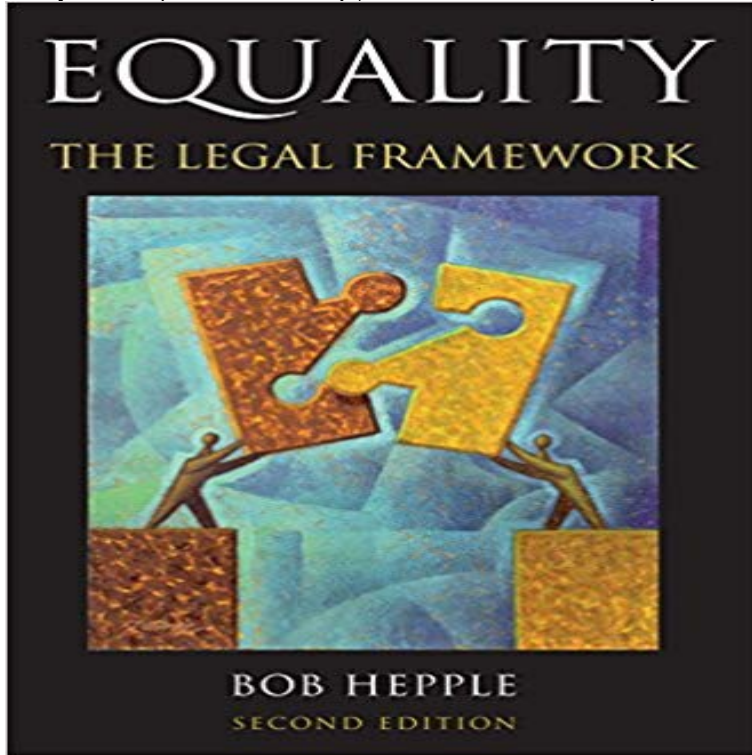


## Equality: The Legal Framework (Second Edition)
