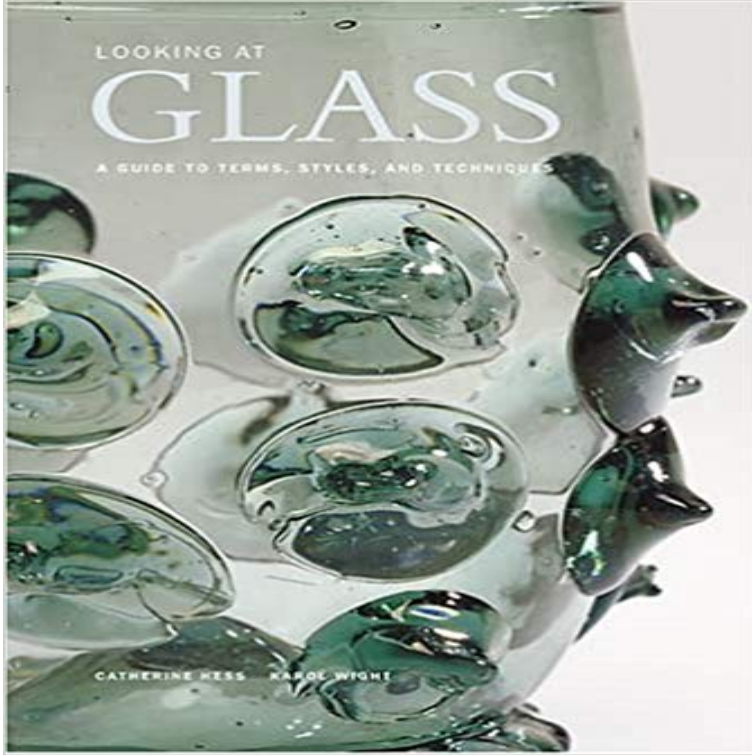


# Looking at Glass: A Guide to Terms, Styles, and Techniques
