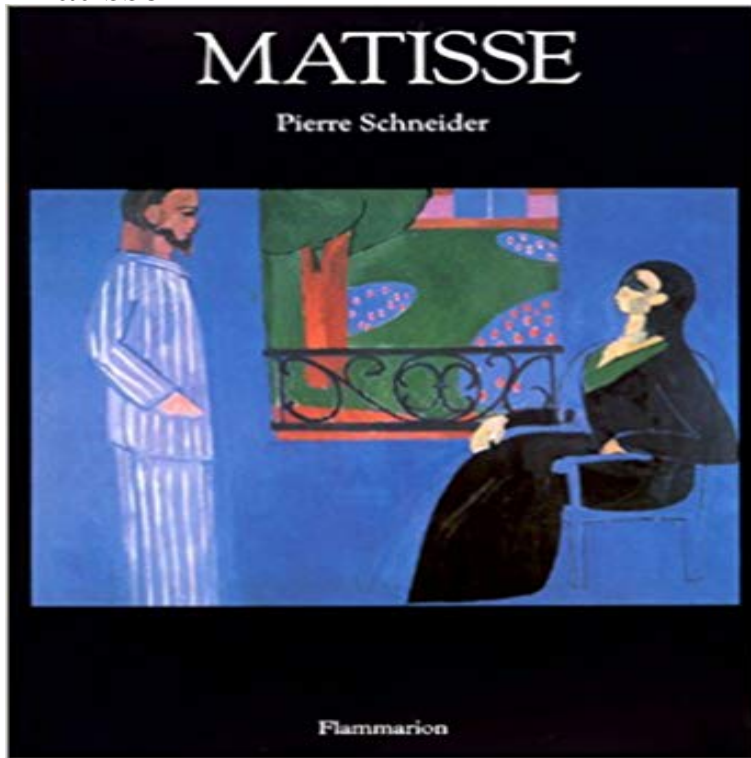


# Matisse
