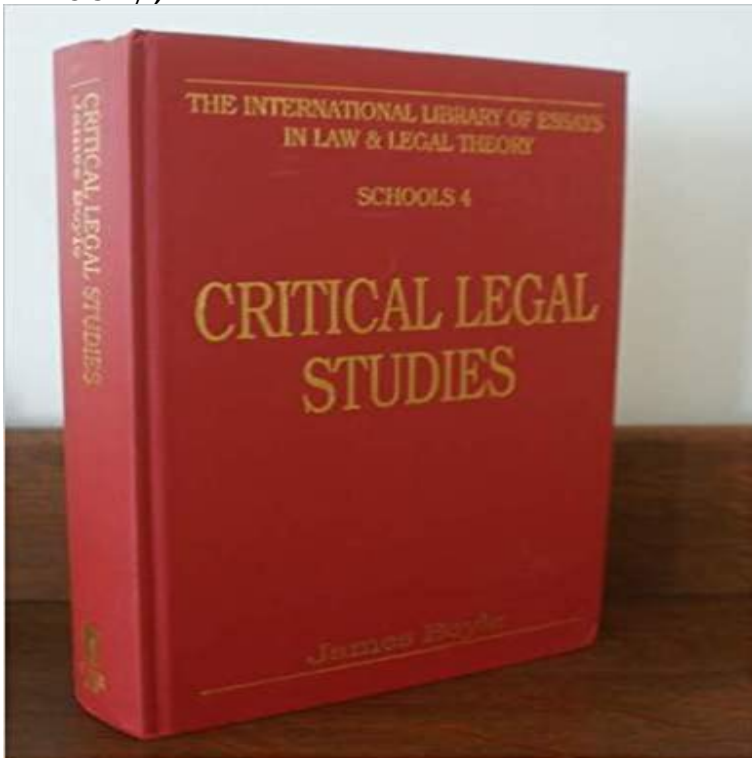


# Critical Legal Studies (International Library of Essays in Law and Legal Theory)
