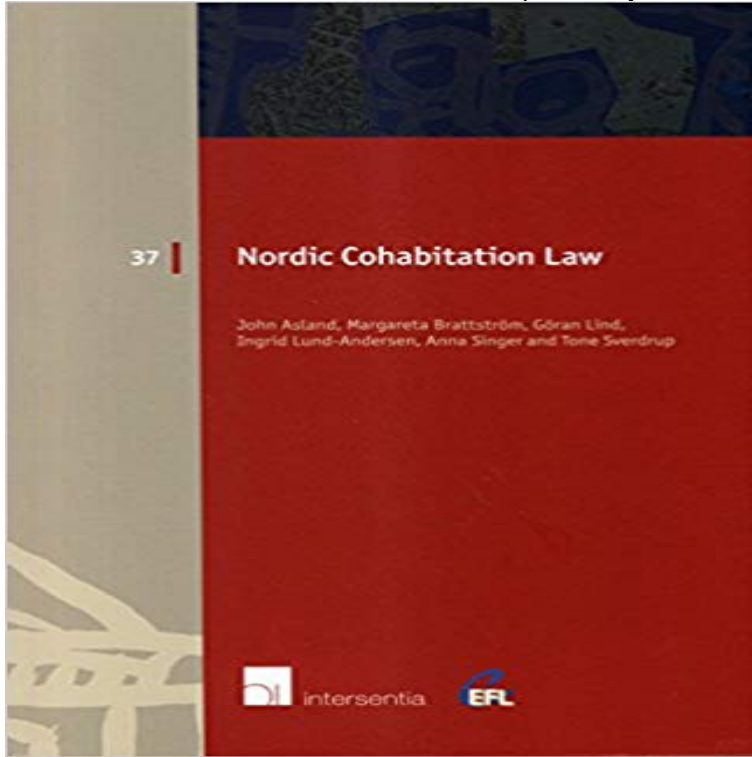


Nordic Cohabitation Law (European Family Law)
