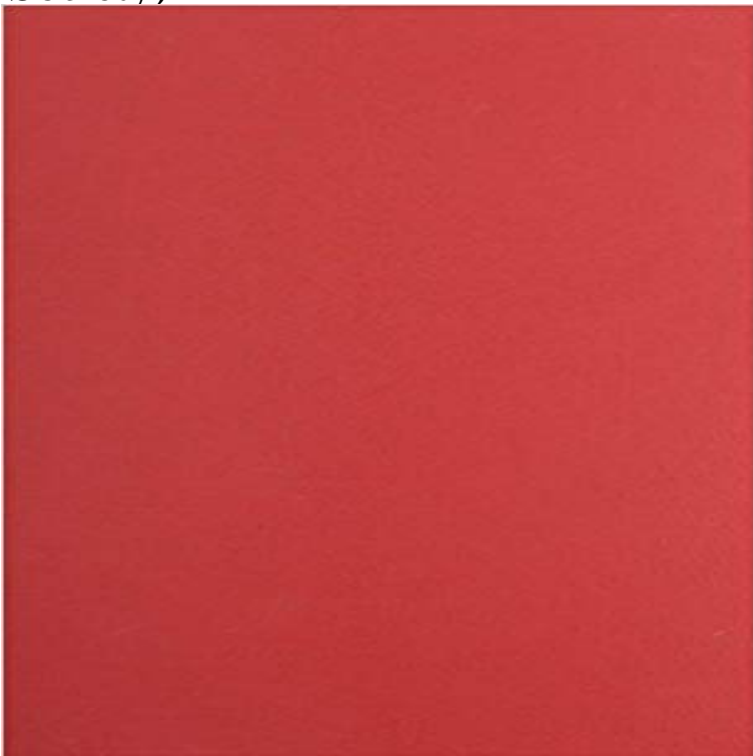


Pay for Play: A History of Big-Time College Athletic Reform (Sport and Society)
