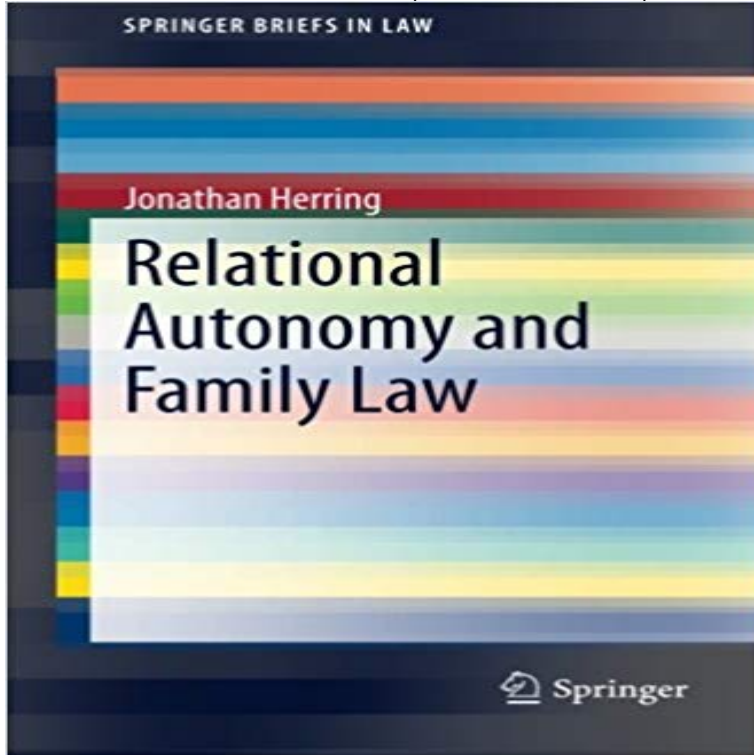


# Relational Autonomy and Family Law (SpringerBriefs in Law)
