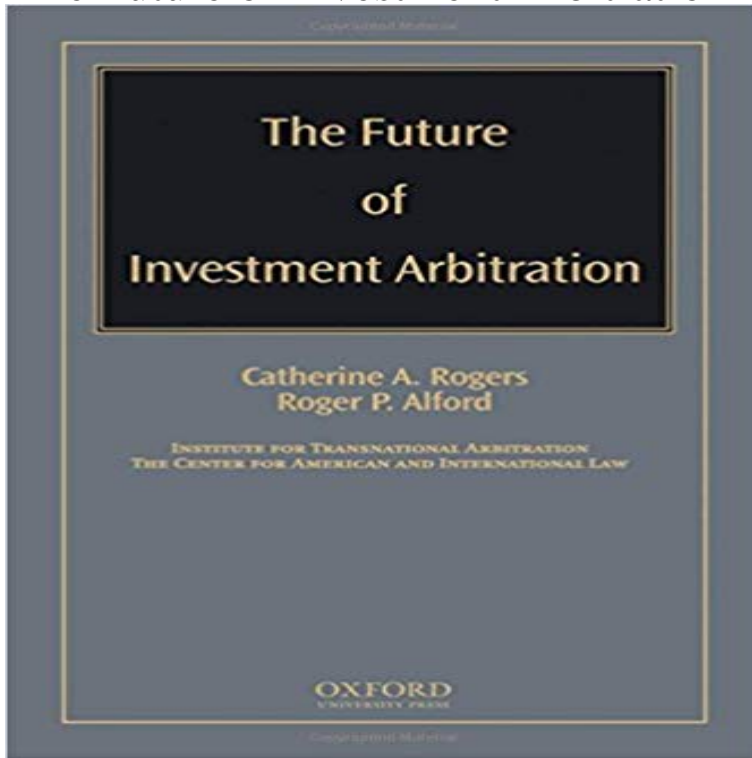


# The Future of Investment Arbitration
