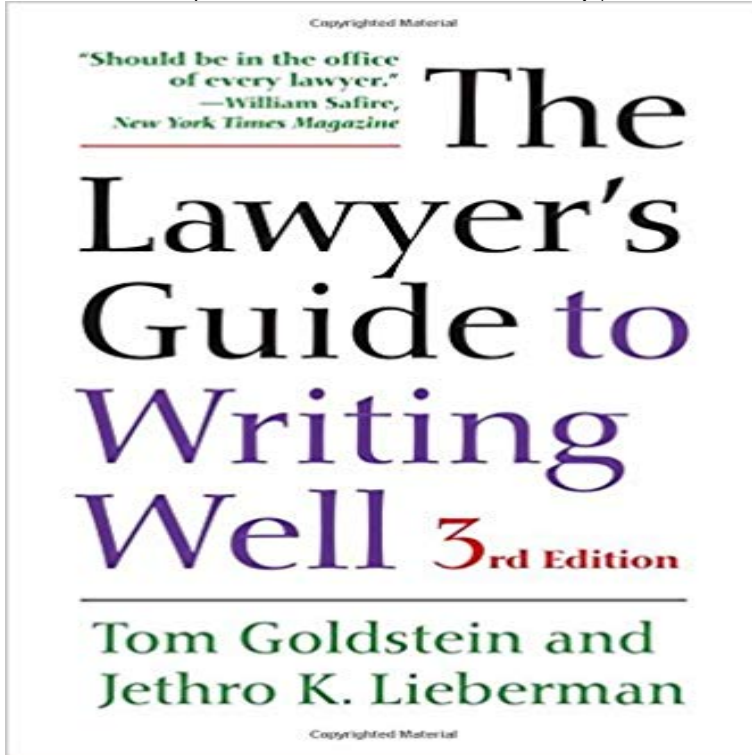


The Lawyers Guide to Writing Well
